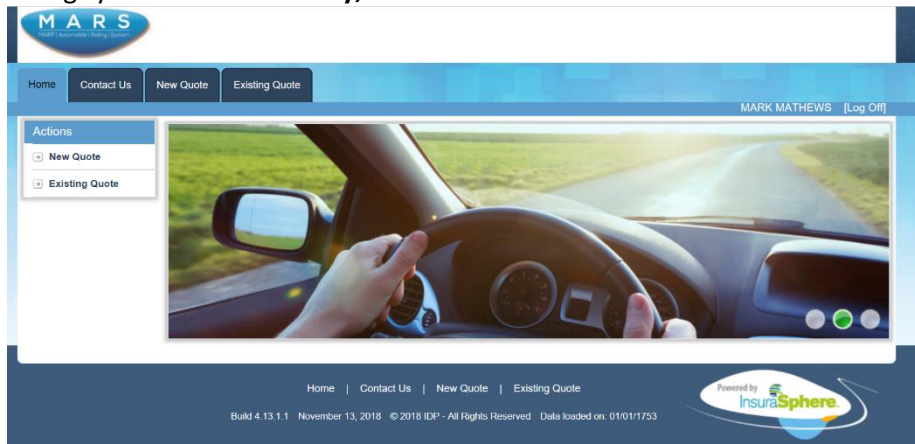

MAIPF is pleased to announce that Private Passenger auto rating will become available in the new MARS rating system on **Wednesday, March 4.**



We have developed a job aid for producers that highlights the major changes between EASi and the MARS system, including the process for adding the coordinated PIP medical discount. All producers are strongly encouraged to review this job aid, as improper completion of MAIPF applications may result in violations being assigned to the producer.
